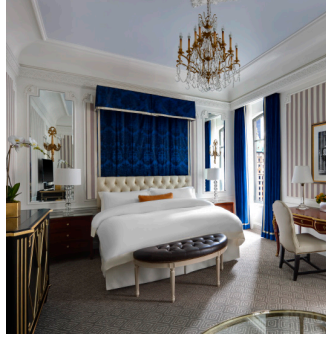




# ST REGIS

## HIGHLIGHTS OF NEW YORK CITY

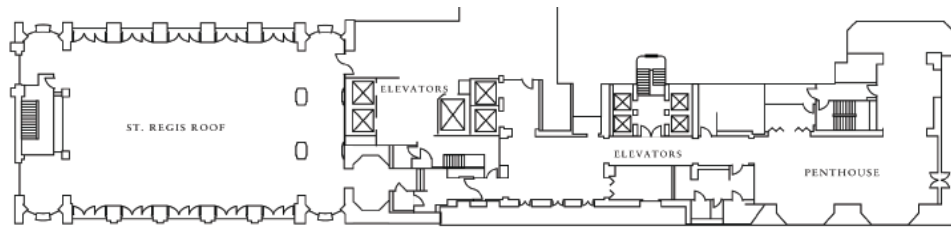

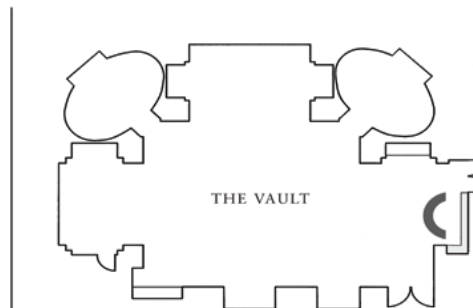
THE ST. REGIS ROOF - TWENTIETH FLOOR BALLROOM
